Starting as early as the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, state and local governments will need to significantly rework the statistical section of their comprehensive annual financial report to comply with the provisions of the Governmental Accounting Standards Board's (GASB) *Statement No. 44, Economic Condition Reporting: The Statistical Section*.
