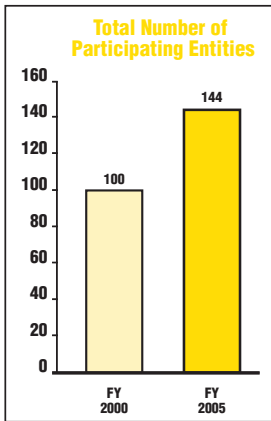

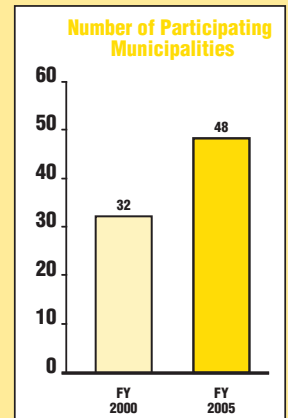
About the Program

Popular Annual Financial Reports

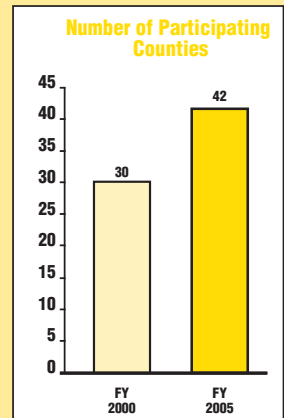

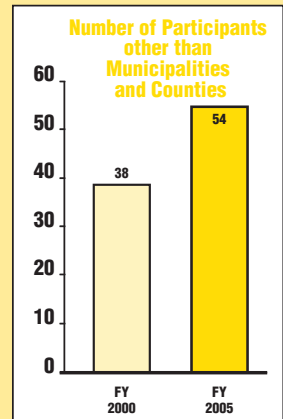
