Who is eligible to become a reviewer?

Any finance professional with at least one year of budget experience with a state or local government (there is no requirement to have served as a finance director).

How will I benefit from my experience on the Review Panel?

- By becoming familiar with the appropriate criteria for assessing the quality of budget documents.
- By getting ideas from other governments' budget documents.
- By becoming familiar with the latest trends in budgeting.
- By profiting from the comments of other budget reviewers.
- By obtaining recognition for your own expertise and professionalism.

What can I expect?

- You will be asked the types of budgets you wish to review (size and type of government) and the months you are available to perform reviews.
- You will then receive no more than one budget in a given month.
- A review should take only a few hours, and can be returned electronically.
