Who is eligible to become a PAFR Reviewer?

Finance officers, staff, auditors, academics—anyone with a solid understanding of governmental accounting and financial reporting and a commitment to making financial information accessible to citizens.

- By becoming familiar with the appropriate criteria for assessing the quality of popular annual financial reports.
- By getting new and creative ideas from other governments' popular annual financial reports.
- By getting familiar with the latest trends in popular annual financial reporting.
- By profiting from the comments of other reviewers.
- By obtaining recognition for your own expertise and professionalism.

What can I expect?

- You will receive no more than three popular annual financial reports to review in the course of a year using a simple checklist.
- An individual review should take no more than two hours.
- Reviews can either be filed electronically, faxed, or mailed.
