Who is eligible to become a reviewer?

Finance officers, staff, auditors, academics—anyone with expertise in governmental accounting and financial reporting who either

- has participated in preparing or auditing a CAFR that has been awarded the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting or
- has equivalent experience and is recommended by a past or current SRC member.

How will I benefit from my experience as a reviewer?

- Gain a better understanding of the practical application of generally accepted accounting principles (GAAP) in a wide variety of circumstances.
- View a wide variety of acceptable methods of presentation and disclosure.
- Get practical ideas for improving your own government's financial reporting.
- Test your skills by receiving feedback on your reviews.
- Obtain recognition for your own expertise and professionalism.

What can I expect?

- You will be able to indicate how many reports you are willing to review each year, during what months, and for what specific types of governments.
- You will be asked to perform reviews using easy-to-follow guidelines with helpful references and explanations.
- A typical review should take from two to four hours.
- Reviews can either be filed electronically, faxed, or mailed.
