**Program Overview**

Many state and local governments face significant remediation costs as a result of past pollution within their jurisdiction. The Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB) will soon issue detailed authoritative guidance on how to calculate and report such pollution remediation obligations. This latest GASB guidance, with its probability-weighted approach to calculating the amount of the liability, marks a significant departure from traditional public- and private-sector practice as set by Financial Accounting Standards Board Statement No. 5, *Accounting for Contingencies*. This two-hour live, interactive, Internet training session will combine lecture and exercises to thoroughly acquaint participants with the key elements of the new guidance from a practitioner perspective.
