OTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

- High bandwidth is recommended and will ensure you can view the web-streaming event without delay and the picture/sound coming and going. We recommend having a wired Internet connection with a minimum connection speed of 1 Mbps.
- It is recommended that you use a PC with Windows and Internet Explorer 7.0 or higher. If you are using a Mac, please use the Safari web browser with a high speed/ broadband Internet connection.
- Make sure you have pop-ups disabled in your Internet browser settings.
- Make sure that your Internet browser is Active X enabled.
- WiFi is not recommended. The problem with WiFi is that the signal strength can vary, causing bandwidth to increase and decrease.
- We recommend using a wired connection. A wired connection gives a consistent signal and consistent bandwidth. A wired connection provides a better experience.
- It is better for organizations with low bandwidth to only have the session running on 1 computer in a conference room than to have 10 individual people running the session on 10 computers at their desks.
- Audio (sound) is projected through your computer speakers. Be sure your computer is equipped with speakers so you can hear the presenters.
